



## **ATHLETES CODE OF CONDUCT**

1. The aim of this code is to enable all trainees to flourish, feel happy and safe and achieve their full potential in a caring environment. Please remember trainees are participating in a dangerous sport. We understand that certain trainees, in their home environment, may be able to behave differently, but on a training camp run by Kandahar Racing it is important for the well-being of all concerned that all trainees adhere to the same Code of Conduct.

a) Trainees of all ages and at all times are not permitted to smoke tobacco, consume alcohol or use any recreational or performance enhancing drugs.

b) Medicinal drugs may only be taken with the full knowledge of Kandahar Racing staff.

c) Trainees are not allowed to engage in any sexual activity of any kind.

d) Trainees are not allowed to enter a bedroom belonging to a trainee of the opposite sex at any time.

e) Trainees must not behave in a discriminatory manner.

f) Trainees must not commit physical, mental or cyber bullying.

g) Trainees must observe Health & Safety rules and the FIS Skier's Code.

h) Trainees must strictly observe bed times.

i) Trainees must follow instructions from any Kandahar Racing member of staff.

j) Trainees shall conduct themselves with good manners at all times and bad language must not be used.

k) Trainees must be considerate to others.

l) Trainees are not allowed to leave the hotel/camp without permission from Kandahar Racing staff. Staff members include all management, coaches, house parents and tutors.
